## Christ's Love Is Kind

1 Corinthians 13:4 & John 13:34

Introduction: You're Mean! You're Reckless! You're Unloving! You're Un-Christ like!

- 1. <u>LOVE</u>: AGAPE ( noun ἀγάπη , verb ἀγαπάω )
  - A. Unregenerate, unsaved people have a quality of this form of love, Luke 11:43.
  - B. Regenerated, saved people can demonstrate two qualities of this form of love, John 13:34; 1 John 3:11, 12.
  - C. The Christ-like quality of this form of love is to be righteously directed only to ones God the Father loves, Heb. 12:6; John 13:34.
- 2. KIND: CHRESTEUOMAI (verb- χρηστεύομαι, noun- χρηστός, Green pg. 205)
  - A. Christ-like AGAPE love acts kind, 1 Cor. 13:4.
  - B. Kindness is defined: gentle, benign, useful, profitable, good, agreeable in the Greek lexicons.
  - C. Scripture defines it to be the characteristic of having a "mellow benevolence": Matt. 11:30 a yoke, Luke 5:39 old wine, God the Father to all Jews Luke 6:35; God the Father to the lost Rom. 2:4; the Lord to Christians 1 Pet. 2:3; Christian to another Christian Eph. 4:32.

## 3. Christ-likeness Demonstrated in the Gospels:

- A. Towards Satan's Sons/Children John 8:44; Matt. 23:13-36
- B. Towards false doctrine Luke 16:1-12 (non-responsive); Luke 12:20 (called them fools or morons); Matt. 23:17-23 (expose and correct)
- C. Towards Satan working through believers Luke 16:13-16; 17-20.
- D. Towards fleshly practices Matt. 21:12-17 (ignores them and speaks to a third person); John 2:13-16 (exposes and corrects)
- E. The exhortation given to spiritual Christians Eph. 4:26
  - Be angry (explosive wrath that is quickly released)
  - Sin not by adding alongside the anger other things over time: hatred, bitterness, unforgiving spirit, murder, slander, etc.)
