Metaphors of the Church ~ "The Christ"

Introduction: There are four major metaphors in the Bible concerning the Church. These metaphors are representations of different aspects of the Church, emphasizing different and sometimes similar characteristics of the Church. These characteristics may be temporal or eternal, the context in which they are found will determine.

The four major metaphors concerning the Church are: The Shepherd and a Flock of Sheep, the Vine and the Branches, the Temple of God, and the Christ (the Head and the Body of Christ, *i.e.* "the New Man"). Today we will return our attention to studying "the Christ". The Christian is to embrace what he is, and what he shall be by the Grace from God.
