The Final Preparation for Repopulating the Earth

- A. Day Four (Gen. 1:16-19).
- a) The sun, moon and stars are worked on (v. 16).
 - b) The canopy is transparent (v. 17).
 - c) The earth's rotation related to the sun: 24 hours (v. 14).
 - d) The earth's axial tilt established: seasons (currently 23.4°).
 - e) The moon's orbit around earth established (v. 16).
 - f) The earth's orbit around sun established: a year (v.14).
 - g) The darkness now not like in verse 2 (v. 18).
 - h) It pleases God that setting for rehabilitation ready (v. 18).

The Second Creation of New Inhabitants Begins

- B. Day Five, (Gen. 1:21).
- a) Soul of life created for 'lower order' animals and whales (v. 21).
 - b) Animals' soul animates: life (Lev. 17:11, 14).
 - c) Each specific "kind" created (vv. 20-21).
 - d) God tells the animals to propagate (v. 22).
 - e) Repopulating the earth pleases God (v. 21).
 - f) Second 24 hour day (v. 19 *cf.* 5, 8, 13).
- C. Day Six, the second day of creation (Gen. 1: 24-27; 2:7, 21-23).
- a) Soul of life created for 'higher order' animals (v. 24).
 - b) Each specific "kind" created (v. 24).
 - c) The animals' re-habitation of earth pleases God (v. 25).
- D. Day Six, Adam's immaterial parts created; Adam is an individual till Gen. 5:2.
- a) In the likeness of God (v. 27)
 - i. The ability to reason (1 Cor. 2:11).
 - ii. The difference from animals (Jam. 3:7-9).
 - b) In the image of God (v. 27).
 - i. God's image is light (2 Cor. 4:4-6; Lu. 2:9).
 - ii. Adam's changed after fall (Gen. 5:3; 1 Cor. 15:49).
 - c) Adam's body formed (Gen. 2:7).
 - d) Adam's given the breath of lives (Gen. 2:7).
