 - God the Father's specific objective for disciplining His sons (Heb. 12:11).
1. The Christian may go past the point of no return (Heb. 10:26-31).
 - a. Willfully
 - b. After full experiential knowledge of the truth.

 2. God will not be mocked by believers (Gal. 6:4-9).
 - a. We reap what we sow—in this life.
 - b. Eternal life recognized.

 3. Practicing immorality while trying to claim religious benefits (1 Cor. 10:6-9).
 - a. Idolatry
 - b. Challenging the Head—Body relationship.
