

The Christian Sin unto Death Part 5
In 1 Corinthians

1. Practicing immorality while trying to claim religious benefits (1 Cor. 10:6-9).
 - a. Idolatry (Ex. 32).
 - b. Challenging The Christ: the Head—Body relationship.
2. Defiling the local church’s testimony; the collective dwelling place for the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 3:16-20; Eph. 2:19-22).
 - a. Plural “you,” “ye.”
 - b. A Holy of Holies.
 - c. Local church—called out ones, called out from the world (Jn. 15:18-19).
 - d. Dwell-inhabit-home; God is holy.
3. Each individual Christian is also a dwelling place for the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 6:13-16).
 - a. Each individual saved in realm of his human spirit.
 - b. Plural “you.”
 - c. Singular human “body” vv. 18, 19, 20.
4. Not discerning the Body interdependence (1 Cor. 11:29-34).
 - a. Approve yourself in relationship to the body (1 Cor. 5:7-8).
 - b. Unleavened bread: distinguish, make differences.
 - c. Chastening makes Christians different from the world; it keeps us saved in the present tense.
