

Spiritual Enemy Number One: the Flesh, Part Six

- Know your spiritual enemies.
- The Christian has two natures that are in conflict with one another (1 Jn. 1:8, 10).
- Galatians Five “works” *cf.* “lusts;” same thing, different emphasis (Rom. 13:13-14; 1 Cor. 10:6-7); “works” called “lusts”.
- Victory by being filled by the Holy Spirit—He makes up what is lacking (Eph. 5:18).

“Now the works of the flesh are plainly seen . . .” 17 works plus (Gal. 5:19): **1-4.** Sexual works; **5.** Idolatry: placing something equal to God. **6.** Witchcraft (Gal 5:20) is religious superstitious awe.

12. Seditious, or cliques: separation within the group.

13. Heresies, misapplication of doctrine, distinct from perversion which is denial of truth.

A. When in the singular translated *sect*, when in the plural translated *heresies*.

B. 1 Cor. 11:19

- a. Lost symbolism of the Lordian Table.
- b. Forsook the unity in Christ.
- c. Embraced disunity outside position in Christ.

C. 2 Pet. 2:1

- a. Taught limited atonement.
- b. Did not recognize the total sufficiency of Christ’s work.
- c. Another of the same sort of Jesus (2 Cor. 12:4).
- d. Different kind of Gospel.
- e. Different kind of Grace.

D. Tit. 3:10: “Heretick”

- a. Misapply Old Testament
- b. Misapply the Law.
- c. Want “one people of God.”
