

The Lusts Satan Perpetrates

- The danger on not taking Satan seriously and literally.
- Lucifer's fall: to be like God (2 Cor. 11:14).
- Satan has the ability to disrupt the mind as it works towards a conclusion. (τα νόημα) Literally means "*the results of the workings of the mind, or the things resulting from the workings of the mind.*"
- Satan attacks the Christian through the human spirit in contrast to the flesh which attacks through the soul (2 Cor. 11:3 cf. 1 Pet. 2:11).
- Satan cannot touch a Christian.
- Satan cannot incite man's sin nature; however, he does take advantage of the sin nature's activity.
- Satan's titles describe his character (Rev. 12:9).
- Satan as god of this Present Evil Age is opposed to Eternal Life.

The Lust Satan puts in Christian's minds.

1. Independence from God (Job 2:9-10; Gen. 3:5; Jam. 4:13-17).
2. Disappointment and Discouragement (Job 19:1-19).
3. Bitterness (Job 7:11; 10:1; Eph. 4:31; Col. 3:19; Jam. 3:14; Heb. 12:15).
4. Doubt (not like in O. T. Jug. 6:36-40 cf. Heb. 11:1; Rom. 14:23).
5. Cowardice in Spiritual Things (Lu. 22:31-33; Jn. 18:15-17, 25, 27; 2 Tim. 1:7-8).
