- Doctrine for Christians desirous of living a spiritual life.
- The disruption thoughts from a spiritual enemy: thought—counter thought.
- The Lusts Satan may put into Christian's minds: 1. Independence from God (Gen. 3:5); 2. Disappointment "Why me?" (Job 3:1-13); 3. Discouragement "God doesn't care about my problems." (Job 19:1-19); 4. Bitterness (Job 7:11; 10:1; Acts 8:23; Eph. 4:31; Heb. 12:15); 5. Doubt is spiritual things (Rom. 14:23). 6. Cowardliness regarding spiritual things "butterflies".
 7. Pride: puffed up, high minded, swell headed.
