 - 1. Independence from God; 2. Disappointment;
 - **3.** Discouragement; **4.** Bitterness; **5.** Doubt; **6.** Cowardliness;
 - 7. Pride; 8. Lying.
- **1.** Satan is the father of his own spiritual family (Jn. 8:41; 1 Jn. 3:10).
 - 1) Unsaved have no guard against Satan.
 - 2) They willingly do his lusts.
 - 3) He speaks of his very own things, not truth.
- **2.** Satan is the father of The Lie (Jn. 8:44; Rom. 1:25).
 - 1) The Lie is antipodal to truth regarding God.
 - 2) The Lie is that "you can put something alongside God."
- **3.** Satan as the power behind governments (Dan. 4:17).
 - 1) New Testament mysteries (Rom. 16:25-26; Col. 1:26).
 - 2) "Something previously hidden but now revealed."
 - 3) Not hard to understand.
 - 4) Necessary for Christians to mature.
- **4.** The Mystery of Lawlessness (2 Thess. 2:3-12).
 - 1) The man of sin; 1st beast of Rev. 13 (v. 3).
 - 2) He will not be revealed until the Holy Spirit is no longer resident on earth.
 - 3) He peddles The Lie empowered by Satan.
