Things change Part 2

I. Introduction and background

- 1. The Rapture is the next event revealed in God's prophetic calendar, "We" (1 Cor. 15:51-52; 1 Thes. 4:14, 15, 17).
- 2. There are no "signs of the times;" no prophecy need to be fulfilled before the Rapture.

II. The man of sin

- 1. He will not be revealed until the church is gone (1 Thes. 2: 3-6).
- 2. He is the first beast of Revelation 13.
 - 1) He is a Gentile (Rev. 13:1 cf. v. 11).
 - 2) He will become world dictator at Mid-Tribulation (Rev. 13:5; Dan. 7:25 ⁹¹¹).

III. When the Church departs earth the Holy Spirit also leaves (2 Thes. 2:6-8).

- 1. The man of sin then becomes predominate on the world stage.
- 2. In every generation Satan has been ready with someone to empower as the man of sin.

IV. The Man of Sin is taken rendered inactive by, or with a "breath" from Christ's mouth (2 Thes. 2:8).

- 1. He sent directly to lake of fire (Rev. 19:20; 20:10; Dan. $8:25^{913}$; $11:45^{919}$).
- 2. He is sent away at Christ's Second Coming.

V. The Man of Sin is taken at, or by the brightness of His Second Coming (2 Thes. 2:8).

- 1. Brightness has the idea of striking splendor.
- 2. There is a sign for His Second Coming (Mt. 24:27-31; Rev. 21:9-11; Heb. 12:18, 22; 13:10-14).

VI. There will be no second chance for those "left behind." (2 Thes. 2:10-11).

- 1. Those exposed to the Gospel before the Rapture.
- 2. They belief The Lie—that you can put something alongside God (Rom. 1:25).
- 3. They willfully believe not the truth regarding God.
- 4. They had pleasure in unrighteousness.

VII. Believers are not to misuse imminent Rapture truth.

- 1. Do not misapply early church practice (Acts 5:32-36).
 - 1) The next event they knew about was the Glory (Acts 3:18-19).
 - 2) They had not revelation regarding the Dispensation of Grace or the Rapture (Acts 9:15; 22:10; 26:16; *cf.* Eph. 3:2-9).
 - 3) Paul personally warned those at Thessalonica to continue to work (2 Thes. 2:5; 3:1, 4-5, 8-13).
