

## When We're Gone!

- I. The Rapture is the next event revealed in God's prophetic calendar, "We" (1 Cor. 15:51-52; 1 Thes. 4:14, 15, 17).**
  1. A forceful snatching away to a formal meeting in the air (1 Thes. 4:17).
  2. An up-gathering up to Him; collected up to Him (2 Thes. 2:1).
  3. A complete unloosing of our limited body (Rom. 8:23).
  4. A glorified body like His (Phil. 3:20-21 *cf.* Rom. 8:29-30).
  
- II. There is a rapid acceleration of events after we're gone since the Restrainer, Holy Spirit, leaves with the church (2 Thes. 2:3-9).**
  
- III. The Nation Israel will return to the place of blessing.**
  1. During the Dispensation of Grace the Gentiles are in the place of blessing (Rom. 11:17-21).
  2. The Dispensation of Grace ends with the Gentiles being taken from the place of blessing (Rom. 11:22).
  3. After the church is gone, the Nation Israel returns to the place of blessing (Rom. 11:23-24).
  
- IV. After we're gone there will be worldwide political discord (Mt. 24:6).** *Note: see Old Schofield Bible page 914 for full explanation of all 70 weeks of years.*
  1. The majority of Jews will return to Israel (Ez. 20:33-34; Micah 5:3; Ez. 38:8, 11, 14).
    - 1) Identification as to race.
    - 2) Identification as to tribe.
  2. Temple reconstruction begins (Dan. 9:24, 27).
  3. The man of sin offers a solution.
    - 1) The man of sin is brought to prominence by the ecclesiastical power (Rev. 17:3).
    - 2) The man of sin manages a confederacy of ten western leaders from countries occupied by the old Roman Empire (Dan. 7:23-24).
  4. The 70 weeks of years are calculated by Jewish occupation of Jerusalem (Dan. 9:24).
  5. The 70<sup>th</sup> week of years begins with the signing of the seven year peace covenant—a false peace (Dan. 8:25; 9:27; Rev. 6:2; Mt. 24:4; 1 Thes. 5:3).
