Satan—The Enemy

- **I.** Lucifer ruled from a place prepared by God (Ez. 28:11-19).
 - 1. God prepared an ideal setting for him to rule.
 - 2. After his fall his wisdom was corrupted and he became a "workaholic."
 - 3. He has been judged but his entire sentence has not yet been carried out.
 - 4. Christians are to be aware of how he can outwit us and affect our minds (2 Cor. 2:11).
- **II.** Satan had his sphere of authority limited:
 - 1. He is limited to the earth's atmosphere (Eph. 2:2).
 - 2. He has only 1/3 of the angels (Rev. 12:4 cf. 1 Tim. 5:21).
 - 3. He rules most of mankind (Lu. 4:5-6 *cf.* Jn. 15:18-19).
 - 4. He has a moveable throne (Rev. 2:13).
 - 5. He is optimistic till Mid-Tribulation (Rev. 12:12).
- III. To resist Satan God provides the Christian armor.
 - 1. Before the Christian is able to put on the armor from God, he must already be relatively victorious over the sin nature (Eph. 6:10).
 - 2. Three words for power:
 - 1) KJV "strong" = empowerment, inherent strength.
 - 2) KJV "power" = manifest might, action.
 - 3) KJV "might" = provided power, enduement.
 - 4) Translation of Ephesians 6:10: Finally, my brothers you empower yourselves in the Lord and by the manifest power (action) by the ability He provides. Interpretation: Use your position in Christ as Lord and have it be seen in action by the ability He provides (cf. Phil. 3:10). Then put on the armor.
- **IV.** The progression in maturity (1 Jn. 2:12-14).
 - 1. The young children who under instruction experientially, through action, have in the past and are knowing the Father (v. 13; Rom. 6:11).
 - 2. The young men have and still are overcoming the malignantly evil one (vv. 13-14).
 - 1) They have an enduement of power.
 - 2) The word concerning God is at ease in them.
