The Change in the meaning of 'Love'

- I. Review of New Testament 'love'.
 - 1. Part of the fruit from the Spirit (Gal. 5:22).
 - 2. New in quality (Jn. 13:34).
 - 3. New standard:
 - 1) Now "as I loved you", a divine enabling.
 - 2) Was "as you love yourself" (Mt. 22:39; Mk. 12:31).
 - 4. New neighbor: now another Christian was another Jew (Eph. 4:25; Lev. 19:18).
- **II.** The New Commandment is not a modification of the Ten Commandments.
 - 1. "New" in quality: fresh, recently made.
 - 2. Not stated in negative terms as the 10 commandments.
 - 3. The New Commandment cannot be 'broken'.
 - 4. The New Commandment has no stated penalty.
- **III.** All except one of the 10 Commandments is conceptually restated in the New Testament where they become indications of carnality; this does not mean that Christians have lower standards.
 - 1. The 10 Commandments were general rules that 'make sense' in a civil society, with one exception (Rom. 2:14).
 - 2. The Law consisted of the 10 Commandments, the statutes, and the judgments (Duet. 7:11, Rom. 7:7).
 - 3. All The Law was to be followed, no picking and choosing (Gal. 5:2-3).
 - 4. The Law was a ministry of death (2 Cor. 3:7).
 - 5. The Law was designed to cause a remembrance of sin—guilt (Heb. 10:1-3).
 - 6. The Law was designed to expose the sin propensity/nature of mankind (Rom.7:7).

V. "Honor parents"	Death (Ex; 21:15, 17; Lev. 20:9).	(Eph. 6:1-2; Col. 3:20)
VI. "Do not murder"	Death (Ex. 21;12, 29; Lev. 24:17).	(1 Pet. 4:15).
VII. "Do not commit adultery"	Death (Lev. 20:10-15).	(1 Cor. 6:18).
VIII. "Do not steal"	Sometimes Death (Ex. 21:16; Duet. 24:7). Other times proportional restitution (Ex. 22:1-5).	(1 Pet. 4:15).
IX. "Do not lie"	Proportional (Duet. 19:15-21).	(Col. 3:9)
X. "Do not covet other's things"	Cf. Rom. 7:7: covet = lust: covetousness, greed, idolatry.	Not focusing on things above (Col. 3:1-2).
