## The Mystery, The Great One

How the Body is preserved to becomes the Bride

- I. The Mystery: The Great One (Eph. 5:25-28, 30, 32).
  - 1. The human husband who loves his wife, loves himself:
    - 1) Because of their relationship to one-to-another (Eph. 5:21-23, 25, 28).
    - 2) This marital bond pictures Christ's relationship to the Church (Eph. 5:23).
  - 2. The saints in the Church are members of the Body of which Christ is the Head (vv. 30, 23).

## **II.** The Current Problems:

- 1. The Body is incomplete except in the mind of Christ (Eph. 4:13).
  - 1) Much of the Church is in heaven (1 Thes. 4:14).
  - 2) Some of the Church is on earth (1 Cor. 15:51).
  - 3) Others of the Church are yet to be saved (Eph. 1:4).
- 2. The members are 'practically', in practice, not always righteous.
- 3. God is Holy and therefore must be separate from all unrighteousness (Rom. 1:18).
- 4. Thus, the entire Body/Church must become cleansed before Christ can present the church to Himself (Eph. 5:26-27).
- III. Christ is currently cleansing the Body members (Eph. 5:25-26).
  - 1. "Lavor" KJV, should be 'washing'.
  - 2. "Word" KJV, should be 'utterance'.
  - 3. This cleansing is by Christ's spoken word now; it is not the purification at the Rapture.
  - 4. When acting lawless, not heeding the restraints from God, Christians are kept saved and not condemned with the world by Christ (1 Cor. 11:30-32; Heb. 7:25).
  - 5. This does not make the Christian without spot, but it does mark out every believer individually, who will be included at the Rapture.
  - 6. This cleansing is unearned; it is provided by the word of Christ.
  - 7. This happens without the believer's knowledge; it is not experienced.
  - 8. However, understanding this cleansing gives knowledge of how and why child training is implemented by the Father.
  - 9. This is different than the cleansing of 1 John 1:9.
