 - 3) Eden Garden of God (v. 13 cf. Gen. 2:8).

 - 5) "Perfect in beauty" (v. 12).

- **II.** Lucifer, described through a third person: 'prop'.
 - 1. His pre-fall condition.
 - 1) As 'perfect' or complete as possible in creation.
 - i. "sum of all that is well-arranged" (v.12).
 - ii. "full of wisdom and perfect in beauty" (v. 12).
 - iii. "the anointed Cherub" (v. 14).
 - iv. "perfect in your ways" i.e., activity (v. 15).
 - v. Created with a bright and shinning luminescence (v. 14, Is. 14:12; 2 Cor. 11:14).
 - 2) Sub-Ruler of the universe from earth.
 - i. "set in Holy Mountain of God" (v.14).
 - ii. Anointed by the Holy Spirit (v. 14, cf. 1 Sam. 10:1, 6; 16:12-14; Is. 61:1).
 - iii. Extra ability and special relationship to Holy Spirit.
 - iv. The one who covers/overshadows, in beauty and rule.
 - v. All this description is beyond any other created being.
 - 3) Eden the Garden of God (v. 13).
 - i. "pipes" is a technical term for the cavity that a jeweler makes for the gem in a setting.
 - ii. There were multiple gemstones in the Garden.
 - iii. These stones flash when Lucifer walks by them (v. 14).
 - iv. A light and music demonstration (vv. 18, 13-14).
