The Mysteries regarding the Church at Pergamos II

- I. Satan infiltrates Christendom, aka Christendumb (Rev. 2:12-17).
 - 1. He makes his home and throne there (v. 12).
 - 2. The people in the church have also made earth their home.
 - 3. Some are holding the doctrine of Balaam.
 - 1) Manipulating God's word.
 - 2) Seeking physical reward and human acclaim.
- II. Some in the church hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans.
 - 1. "Nico" from word meaning 'victory.'
 - 2. "Laitan" from a word meaning 'people'.
 - 3. Compound word means "victory over the people."
 - 4. This sect separates the clergy from the people, not accounting for the fact:
 - 1) That every Christian is a priest (1 Pet. 2:9).
 - 2) That every Christian can offer up spiritual sacrifices (1 Pet. 2:5).
 - 3) That every Christian is an equally valuable member in the Body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:25, 24; 1 Cor. 13:13; Gal. 3:28; Col. 3:11).
- **III.** The promise to the overcomer (v. 17).
 - 1. He will give to eat of the hidden manna.
 - 2. It is not until after the Rapture, and subsequent glorification of our bodies, that Christians will "see" Christ as He is (1 Jn. 3:2).
 - 3. At the Rapture, Christ will not be hidden from Christians.
 - 1) No Christian "sees" Him before the Rapture.
 - 2) Until the Rapture those who have 'gone home' are housed in an intermediate body.
 - 3) Manna was supplied daily to Israel to: (Ex. 16).
 - i. To sustain their physical life.
 - ii. Emphasize and test their dependence on God.
 - iii. To develop their trust in Him.
 - 4) The Bread of Life as a metaphor of His sustaining spiritual life (Jn. 6:31-35).
 - 5) Christians go home to be present with the Lord, but not in His presence.
 - 6) "Hidden manna" will be Christ as He regularly provides evidence of His close proximity to those in intermediate bodies: New Jerusalem, Tree of Life, white stone, *etc.*
