The Creation of Adam and Eve

- I. Adam and Eve were created: (Gen. 1:26-27; 5:1).
 - 1. In the likeness of God: the ability to reason (Jam. 2:9).
 - 1) Reasoning ability is in the realm of the human spirit (1 Thes. 5:23; 1 Cor. 2:11).
 - 2) No animal had a spirit/reason, they have soul only.
 - 2. In the Image of God: illuminating garment of light.
 - 1) The only other illuminating beings are God and Lucifer/Satan.
 - 2) No animal had a garment of light.
- II. God demonstrates to Adam his uniqueness (Gen. 2:7-20).
 - 1. Different from all the animals: image and likeness.
 - 2. Adam had no colleague, companion, or peer in the Garden.
- III. God builds Eve (Gen. 1:21-25).
 - 1. Material parts come from Adam.
 - 2. Immaterial parts also come from Adam (2:7).
 - 3. This order in creation establishes a hierarchy (1 Tim. 2:13).
 - 4. The creation of Eve as a personality is different than procreation (Gen. 53).
- IV. The First Dispensation of Innocence, Innocency
 - 1. A dispensation is stewardship related to all or part of mankind during which there is a test to demonstrate if man can please God.
 - 2. Every dispensation has five elements: 1). A lord 2). A steward 3). A realm of authority 4). A household 5). A time of reckoning (Lu. 12:42-43).
 - 3. Adam is given the sphere of authority—rules:
 - 1) Rule the animal and plant kingdoms (1:28, 2:5-6. 15).
 - 2) Reproduce (1:28).
 - 3) Eat fruit from the tree—vegetarian diet (1:29, 2:9, 16-17); animals were also vegetarian (1:30).
 - 4) Do not eat of the Tree of Knowledge (2:17).
 - i. "Dying you shall die".
 - ii. They would die spiritually and begin to die physically.
 - **V.** During the Dispensation of Innocence:
 - 1. The <u>lord</u> is God.
 - 2. The steward is Adam.
 - 3. The <u>realm of authority</u> is the four rules.
 - 4. The <u>household</u> is Adam and Eve.
 - 5. The day of accountability is when the forbidden fruit is eaten.
